

### AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP



Helping to Grow the Texas Produce Industry

- The amount of the scholarship is \$2,000 (\$1,000/semester).
- Applicant must plan to obtain a bachelor's degree from a Texas college/university that can be applied to the produce industry.
- Applicant must be a high school senior or presently enrolled in a Texas college/university. An applicant may plan to initially enroll in a Texas junior, community, or local college with the intent of transferring to another Texas college/university to obtain a bachelor's degree in a produce related field.
- High school applicants must have maintained a "B" average and college applicants must have maintained a minimum of 2.5 GPA or higher.
- The deadline for submitting applications is June 1st.
